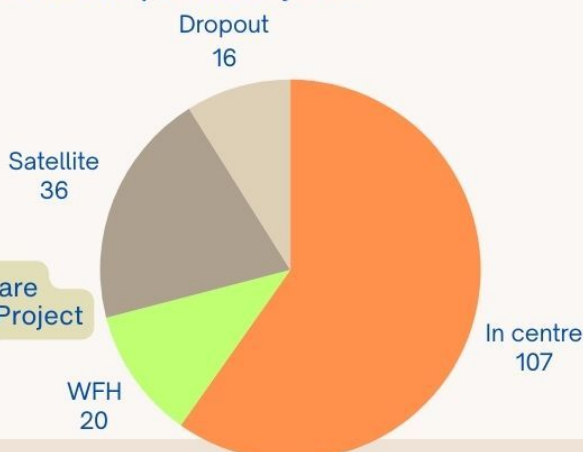
## Project Donna



### Income Generation Project

Project Donna is about creating income generation opportunities for women who have been trained in tailoring, handicraft, and embroidery.

This quarter, our artisans focused on creating samples and transitioning them into production. We also engaged new garment partners and handled a high volume of Christmas orders, resulting in an 87% increase in artisans' livelihood allowance compared to the previous year.

## Project DolaRani



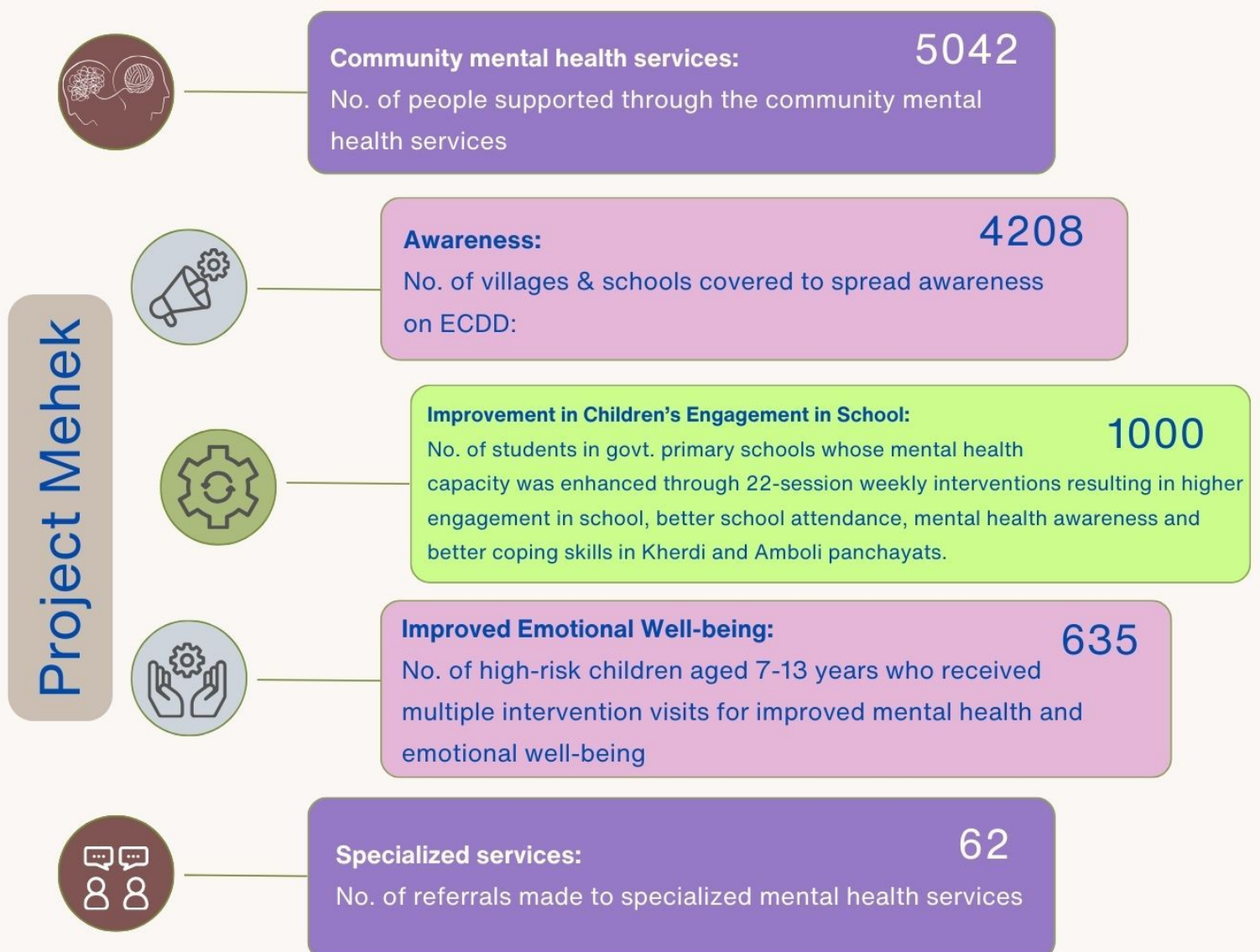
### Skills Development

Project DolaRani (Women leaders of Dolara village), focuses on enabling economic sustainability and psychosocial resilience of Adivasi families by enabling equal opportunity and skills in fostering entrepreneurship in tribal communities, especially amongst disadvantaged women and youth, thereby reducing poverty, strengthening them at a systemic level and enabling them to become change leaders within their communities.

ACT's tailoring program started in January 2024, graduating 19 students in April 2024. The next step is to connect them with markets and income opportunities, paving the way for vocational and livelihood empowerment on a massive scale for hundreds of tribal women in Dadra and Nagar Haveli.
