
We impacted: 5000+ Members and school children who participated in the Program in seven states through Government Schools and Colleges Panchayat Self Help Group / Joint Liability Group.

PROJECT NANHE KADAM – EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT & DISABILITIES

Under Nanhe Kadam Project, we are working on "Early Child Development" for children between 0 to 3 years, and we involve caregivers of the children in the activities within the Early Childhood Champions (ECC) arm of this project. We started the ECC work with ten villages in DNH: Velugaon, Amboli, Parzaii, Kala, Karzgaon, Kherdi, Khanvel, Khutli, Rudana, and Tinoda.

PROJECT MEHEK - COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH AND EMOTIONAL WELL-BEING OF THE CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND WOMEN OF DNH

Since 2019, we trained 13 adivasi members from the community to address the mental health issues of mothers, children, and families. To date, we have connected with over 1000 adivasi families and spent more than 10,000 hours collectively in building relationships of trust, creating emotionally safe spaces for the children, youth, and women, spreading awareness on mental health, sensitizing the masses, and facilitating linkages or referrals to the government's specialized care services.
