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### Meet Kalpana – A homemaker and now an International Conference Speaker

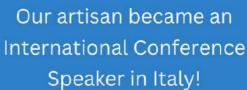
Introducing Kalpana, an exceptional embroidery artisan, and supervisor.

Recently, she had the incredible opportunity to address the audience at the renowned Oxfam Festival in Florence, Italy, alongside our strategic partner, I Was A Sari's Stefano Funari.

Their compelling discussion centered around the vital topic of women's emancipation. They were invited to an exhibition and people from different countries gave speeches.

She was initially filled with nervousness at the thought of speaking in front of such a large crowd. However, her hard work and determination bolstered her courage to share her story. She delivered her speech in Hindi, sharing her journey, work, and beginnings.

Under a mandate by the National Health Mission of the DNH division, Dr. Parvatraj and his team of social workers and psychologists, along with the ACT team conducted a session about the All India Program under NHM called Tele Manas Cell for Mental Health Assistance, which offers 24/7 Tele counseling services in DNH to the Adivasi children, youth, women and families through their toll-free number 14416. Several community members of DNH attended the session.

ACT, through its mental health and emotional well-being program, Mehek has been working since 2019 with children, youth, and women throughout the vulnerable Adivasi communities in DNH and has touched more than 2000 lives through mental health and well-being interventions.

### **Project Mehek**

ACT's Mehek Project currently operates in 9 villages within Dadra Nagar Haveli. 15 local resource persons from within the community trained in community mental health work every week with the students. In Dec 2022, we launched a School Group Wellness Program at Kherdi Government School, District Panchayat with 127 children aged 7-13 years. This initiative has been made possible through the strong support and collaboration of the District Panchayat CEO and the school principal.

### **Project NanheKadam**

Project Nanhe Kadam is overjoyed to share that we've successfully trained and graduated 12 exceptional Community Health Workers (CHWs) under the Early Childhood Championship program (ECC).

Our total field staff on ground in the adivasi villages of DNH comprises 33 members who cover more than 3500 families under these two projects.
