

QUARTERLY UPDATES

ACT is a non-profit in Mumbai, India. We pledge to 'Act to make a difference' for marginalized children, youth, women, and vulnerable communities facing poverty and distress, and lacking opportunities for education and income generation.

This quarter saw a record-breaking income of **₹33.82 lakhs** for **196** artisans, a **40%** increase from last year! We also installed **10** motor-equipped sewing machines in our DolaRani project in Dadra Nagar Haveli (DNH), boosting earnings to **₹6,000** per month per beneficiary woman. Finally, as of December 2024 our DNH Early Childhood Program has benefited **850** children, while Project Nanhe Kadam has positively impacted **1,108** children.



EXHIBITIONS

ACT and I Was a Sari collaborated on exhibitions this quarter, empowering artisans to showcase their skills and boost income. Held in corporate offices, pre-Diwali and Christmas fairs, and a conscious collection event, artisans managed the exhibitions and successfully turned them into a major attraction at these events.

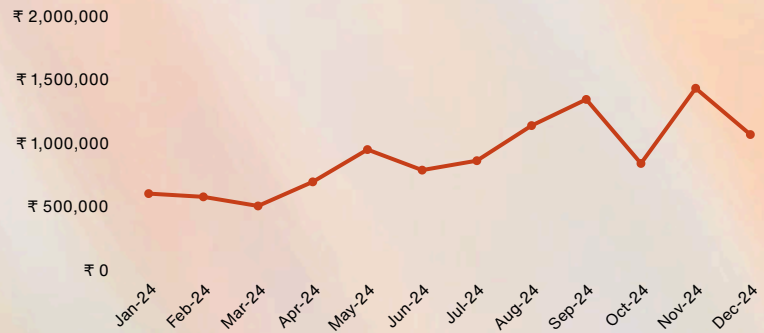
